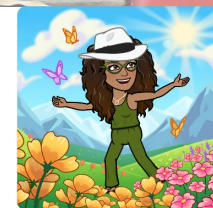

1-3P Working Hard

1-3P students are engaging in fun, interactive and hands on learning activities at school

In **English**, students have explored different phonemes and graphemes. They have read stories linked to the focus grapheme. The focus theme for writing this term is animals. Students have enjoyed writing descriptive text about our school therapy dogs, Lenny and Sade, Mrs Pinto's pet rabbit Poppy and a lion.



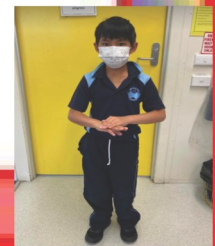
In **Mathematics**, students have done amazing work learning concepts on Whole Numbers, Time, Mass and Volume and Capacity. They are able to label the long and short hands on a clock, show the direction the hands move and read time to the hour, half hour or a quarter hour. In Mass students are able to weigh objects using different informal units.



In **Creative Arts**, students enjoy using different recycled, sensory and craft materials to make creative objects. This is linked to the focus character in a story or the focus phoneme of the week. Students have been learning key word signs to communicate their wants and feelings.

We are so proud of you!



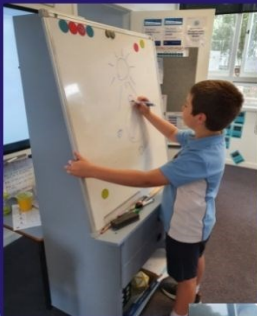
Best moments of 1-3P

3-4N TRAVELS BEYOND THE EARTH'S ATMOSPHERE

Throughout Term 4, 3-4N have been exploring the Earth across all Key Learning Areas.

In English students are learning to persuade their chosen audience to look after the Earth. They are persuading people to grow their own vegetables at home and to stop littering. It is amazing to see how persuasive 3-4N can be when they are passionate about the topic given to them.

In Science students are learning about how the Earth's rotation around the Sun creates seasons and time. We have been increasing our understanding by being hands on and creating our own model of the Earth to demonstrate the orbit of the Earth. Students have looked at how the Earth's orbit around the sun and the moon's orbit around the Earth creates day, months and years.

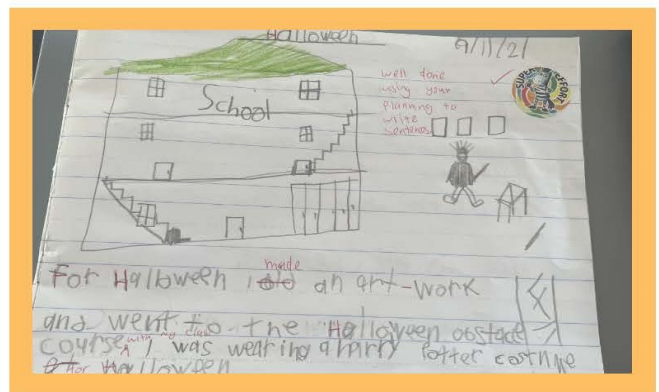
Celebrations!

PARENT ONLINE PAYMENTS

Using Westpac QuickWeb

Dear Parents,

Online payments are accessed through the home page of the school's website:

www.lansvalee-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

The school website will have an option on the menu bar "Make a Payment".

When you click on this you will be taken straight to the Westpac QuickWeb page.

Payers will complete the necessary details, some of which are mandatory before confirming the payment details and completing the payment. A receipt can be printed from the payment page.

The payment screens are:

- Entering payment details
- Entering credit card details
- Confirmation of payment details and
- Online payment receipt

Payments can be made by Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card only. The school does not see any details of your card.

Please ensure you enter the child's correct name, class and details of what you are paying for. These details are necessary so that the payment is credited to the correct child.

All payments made before 6.00pm each day will be received at the school the next day. Payment after 6.00pm will not be received by the school for two days.
