## 1-3P Working Hard

1-3P students are engaging in fun, interactive and hands on learning activities at school

In English, students have explored different phonemes and graphemes. They have read stories linked to the focus grapheme. The focus theme for writing this term is animals. Students have enjoyed writing descriptive text about our school therapy dogs, Lenny and Sade, Mrs Pinto's pet rabbit Poppy and a lion.







In Mathematics, students have done amazing work learning concepts on Whole Numbers, Time, Mass and Volume and Capacity. They are able to label the long and short hands on a clock, show the direction the hands move and read time to the hour, half hour or a quarter hour. In Mass students are able to weigh objects using different informal units.




